**8. Position Description:**

**Duties:**

Assists Director in all logistics programs in Central Command

Develops Joint Logistics Plans and Policy for USCENTCOM AOR and forces

Advises the Commander of logistics implications of all operational plans and alternative courses of action as necessary

Participates in all operational planning to provide adequate logistics support

Determines logistics assets which can be brought to bear on an operation and develops the logistics plans necessary to effect the support of an operation

Evaluates the effectiveness of the logistics support and advises the commander of pending logistics problems

Deals with the components through daily interchanges during peacetime and heightened tensions

Monitors the joint logistics capabilities and readiness of components and assigned forces

Maintains a logistics command and control element (Logistics Operation Division) to support wartime operations and provide logistics representation in the Joint Operations Center; provides the appropriate number of trained personnel for the centers

Maintains liaison via co-located representatives with HQ TRANSCOM AND HQ AMC

Directs theater fuels operations through a Joint Petroleum Office (JPO)

Manages theater NATO infrastructure program and interface with NATO, through SACEUR or direct national contact to ensure adequate support within foreign domain the Central Theater. National joint logistics focus for SACEUR activities

Develops and maintains familiarity with other unified commanders' OPLANS to develop and support Adaptive Joint Force Packaging (AJFP) requirements

Conducts Joint Logistics operations and Exercises

Supports mobilization, deployment, employment, sustainment, redeployment and reconstitution of USCENTCOM assigned forces

Directs crisis planning and execution of all logistics so support the Joint Operations Center and the Logistics Readiness Center

Develops and provides joint logistics to all components and Joint Task Forces (JTF)

Oversees Joint Logistics Automation concepts and use

Assists USCENTOM Inspector General as required in development of logistics guidelines and augmentation to participate in review/inspections

Prioritizes, plans and coordinates theater civil engineer support requirements

Develops combatant command engineer training and exercises programs to evaluate the improve preparedness for Civil Engineer missions

Directs all Engineering programs in Central Command

Directs the development of Civil Engineer support plans and the engineering annexes to OPLANS/COMPLANS in conjunction with the deliberate and crisis action planning process

**9. Special Qualifications/Requirements/Restrictions:**

Requires an officer schooled and broadly experienced in operational logistics

A background as a rated combat arms or line officer is not sufficient. The incumbent should be an officer with a logistics subspecialty code, MOS or AFSC; a multifunctional logistician or an officer of one of the logistics staff corps

The following specialty skill codes required: USA: 90A00 USAF: 20C00, 21LX, 21GX, 21TX

This position is a 2 year active duty tour

Must have a minimum of 18 years satisfactory service

Must be able to complete a minimum 2 years in the assignment before mandatory removal date/mandatory separation date (MRD/MSD)

Must be medically qualified to enter active duty

Must be Federally recognized in the authorized grade (line), hold a Certificate of Eligibility for the authorized grade (line), pending Senate confirmation in the authorized grade, or be eligible to meet the General Officer Federal Recognition Board following selection

Completion of senior service school required
