**Position Description:**

**Duties:**

Serves as the Wartime G2 Eighth United States Army (EUSA)

Primarily responsible for providing all-source intelligence support to the Commanding General, EUSA to facilitate wartime execution of rear area operations with an emphasis on protecting forces within the communications zone (COMMZ) and conducting Reception, Staging, Onward movement, and Integration (RSOI) of U. S. Army Time-Phased Force Deployment (TPFD) units

Coordinates the intelligence operations in support of Non-Combatant Evacuation Operations (NEO)

Advises the Commanding General (CG) and Deputy Commanding General (DCG) for Support, EUSA, Chief of the National Guard Bureau (CNGB), and the Director, Army National Guard (DARNG) on relevant issues

Supervise the intelligence efforts of the EUSA G2 staff during wartime in support of two Theater Command Posts

Personally serves as the Senior Intelligence Officer (SIO) at Command Post Operational Support and Rear Command (CP OSCAR), coordinating intelligence support from USFK J2, Second Republic of Korea Army (SROKA), and the Ground Component Command-Combined Analysis Center (GCC-CAC) for the RSOI and JTF-NEO mission

Ensures the timely dissemination of critical rear area intelligence threat information to EUSA major subordinate commands.

Works with the EUSA G2 to define the Reserve component requirements to support the EUSA armistice and wartime mission requirements

Jointly develops Battle Staff Roster manning requirements explicitly defined by skill, grades, and command post mission responsibility to achieve a fully integrated, active, and reserve military intelligence team, capable of supporting the diverse wartime missions of the EUSA in the Korean Theater of Operations

The intelligence personnel support three major Theater wartime missions: NEO; RSOI; and deep attack operations
