Duties:

Supports the Director in his role as principal advisor to CINCUSJFCOM on all Joint Experimentation Program issues in support of the CJCS Joint Vision 2020 and future CJCS joint warfighting vision

Directs issue resolution and provides management oversight of possible Reserve Components (RC) changes resulting from joint experimentation efforts

Responsible for J9 for enabling the process and an environment for accomplishing national scale experimentation necessary to identify and assess interdependent areas of joint warfare that will leverage Service warfighting and operational capabilities to transform the conduct of future US Armed Forces operations

Assesses the potential impact of these experiments on the role and future capabilities of the RC

Evaluates the plans, designs, prepares, conducts, assesses and recommends the most promising joint concepts and capabilities for experimentation and further assessment for the RC

Identifies required support Reserve forces for participation in specific experiments by coordinating with the Services, combatant commands, and Defense agencies

Review and assesses concept-based hypotheses to identify and recommend solutions for changes in RC doctrine, organization, training, and education, material, leadership, people and facilities (DOTMLPF) required for future joint operational warfighting concepts and capabilities

Serves as the RC joint experimentation focal point for J9 in his dealings with the Services, RC, JS, OSD, coalition agencies and other defense agencies

9. Special Qualifications/Requirements/Restrictions:

This position is M-Day/drill status only

Must have a minimum of 17 years satisfactory service

Must be able to complete a minimum 3 years in the assignment before mandatory removal date/mandatory separation date (MRD/MSD)

Completion of senior service school required

Must be Federally recognized in the authorized grade (line), hold a Certificate of Eligibility for the authorized grade (line), pending Senate confirmation in the authorized grade, or be eligible to meet the General Officer Federal Recognition Board following selection

Must be able to hold TS-SCI clearance along with other special programs
