Duties:

Controls a Unified Command of over 250,000 soldiers, sailors, airmen, and marines during wartime operations

Serves as the principal staff assistant to the Commander in Chief and Deputy Commander in Chief, United States Forces Korea

Directs, coordinates and integrates the actions of a joint staff comprised of USA, USAF, USN, and USMC general officers

Formulates policies for general staff operations during wartime

Primary mission is to supervise the activities of the joint staff to ensure USFK support of United Nations Command and Combined Forces Command wartime operations and accomplishment of USFK mission to defeat armed aggression against the Republic of Korea

Directs the planning and supervise the coordination and execution of noncombatant evacuation order operations from the Republic of Korea

Coordinates the execution of wartime OPLANS in a manner consistent with US National Command Authority guidance

Works closely with counterparts on the United Nations command and Combined Forces Command staffs to ensure seamless integration of USFK ground, air, naval and special operations components into Combined operations

Interfaces with the US Joint Staff to ensure complete understanding of the wartime situation and coordination of necessary support

Provides Title X logistics support in conflict and during RSOI

9. Special Qualifications/Requirements/Restrictions:

Must have knowledge/experience at the operational level of warfare, well versed in theater level campaign planning, and prepared to oversee/direct the execution of those campaigns

Must have previous Joint/Combined experience, completely conversant with US Joint Staff procedures, structure, and C2 relationships with some experience in Combined operations and the problems that derive therefrom

Must have familiarity with Army and Joint logistics operations
