Duties:

During wartime and OPLAN exercises serves as principal advisor to Commander, United States Forces Korea (USFK) on intelligence production, intelligence collection management, counter intelligence, and intelligence planning

Develops intelligence requirements to support command peacetime operations and wartime contingencies

Provides early warning indication of hostility, accomplishes targeting, manages collection/reconnaissance programs and produces integrated intelligence

Directs command counter intelligence, imagery, and security programs

Maintains liaison with CFC, USFK component command staffs, and U.S. government agencies

Manages U.S. intelligence architecture/networks and connectivity to theater, national, and component systems

Represents USFK in Collection Management Board, Force Protection Executive Council and Information Operations Executive Council. Monitors SPECAT traffic flow for USFK command and key staff

9. Special Qualifications/Requirements/Restrictions:

Must have a minimum of 17 years satisfactory service

Must be able to complete a minimum 3 years in the assignment before mandatory removal date/mandatory separation date (MRD/MSD)

Completion of senior service school required
